

Maidstone Squash Club - Car Parking Rules & Etiquette

1. Annual Parking Permits are issued for members' use whilst playing squash and **MUST** be displayed on the front windscreen of members' cars.
2. Parking is only permitted within the confines of the club car park and does not extend to the road.
3. Parking is limited to 3 hours.
4. It is the members' responsibility to ensure that they are displaying an up-to-date permit. **Please be aware that clamping is in operation Monday-Saturday 8.30am – 6.30pm.**
5. Copying of this permit is not permitted and other persons should not use the permit.
6. Six parking spaces are permanently cross-hatched to provide parking for members actively playing squash. A facility will be made for guest permits for visiting teams.
7. Junior members are entitled to a parking permit for their own use only on production of a full current driving licence.

Members are expected to park sensibly with other members in mind and follow the parking etiquette:

- Always park in a rear parking space wherever possible
- Leave a note on the dashboard of your car clearly stating the time of your departure and a contact number.
- Remember to check the time that the member behind wishes to leave the car park and return to your vehicle so that others can leave on time

If operated correctly, all members may enjoy the advantage of free town parking but this is a privilege not a right. Any member who continually abuses the car parking rules risks having their permit withdrawn.
